ENVIRONMENTAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS:

The company agrees to follow the rules and requirements, which will be placed upon all the companies at the site of the event.

1. When serving food and/or drinks, the only accepted types of dishes are either disposable dishes made of recyclable cardboard, washable dishes made of porcelain/glass/hard plastic or edible dishes. The only accepted type of cutlery is wooden.
2. Other types of dishes, like plastic disposable cups or cutlery, can not be used! **If other type than the types accepted is used, the sales will be immediately stopped!**
3. If washable dishes are used, the sales company is responsible for washing the dishes properly, according to the health regulations. There will also have to be a deposit, which will guarantee the return of the dishes.
4. If disposable, recyclable dishes are used, the sales company is required to arrange the recycling in order to minimise the amount of solid waste in the bins.
5. **There will be at least 3 different types of waste sorted within the area:**

LIQUID CONTAINERS

- cardboard cups, drinks cartons etc.

BIOWASTE

- food, cardboard plates, wooden cutlery

SOLID WASTE

- materials that can not be sorted and recycled

Paper will have to be collected and recycled if leaflets and magazines are given out at the event. This is not recommended as it will lead to a bigger amount of rubbish within the area.

The sales personnel will also sort the brown cardboard. A container where the cardboard and also drinks cartons and cardboard packaging can be placed, will be arranged.

All the containers will have stickers, which will enable the proper sorting.

6. **Selling drinks in glass bottles is strictly forbidden for security reasons!** The sales personnel will have to pour the drinks into cups or alternatively sell drinks in plastic, recyclable bottles or aluminium cans.
7. If drinks are sold in plastic bottles or cans, the sales company is responsible for taking back the containers. The containers will also have to be returned through proper collection channels (this also applies for the cans without deposit). For the bigger events, a reverse vending machine may be arranged.
