THEME: MONARCHY AND MONTESQUIEU

Count Joachim Anckarbjelke (Jocke Wigelius) tells about the latest European ideas and their impact on Swedish-Finnish administration in addition to debating with his visitor, Baroness Edlerspjutin (Marjorita Huldén) about the benefits and drawbacks of the monarchy and the strangely threatening atmosphere at the turn of the 1790s. The Lumières Orchestra, including Finnish and visiting Swedish musicians, plays Kraus' Parliament March, and with soloists who include mezzo-soprano Essi Luttinen, tenor Charles Barbier and baritone Petteri Salomaa present parts of Kraus' opera Soliman II and Grétry's opera Richard the Lionheart with the Utopia choir. We will also hear de Lisle's Hymn to Freedom and War Song for the Army of the Rhine, which is now known as the Marseillaise. Text and direction: Anneli Mäkelä
